The CEESOK (Central and Eastern European Society of Koreanologists) Committee is delighted to announce the 20th CEESOK conference for scholars from the Central and Eastern European region, hosted by the Korean Studies Section of the Institute of Classical, Mediterranean and Oriental Studies, University of Wrocław.

CEESOK's objectives are to stimulate and coordinate academic cooperation among Korean Studies in Central and Eastern Europe, as well as to promote the knowledge of Korea among a wider public.

About the conference

The CEESOK Committee encourages proposals that will attract a broad range of scholarly interest by focusing on issues crucial to understanding traditional and contemporary Korea. The theme of this year's conference is "Korea now and in the future: what is to change, what is to stay?" The pace of new phenomena springing up across the world is quickening, and the civilizational landscape across the world is going through an enormous transformation. What cultural and social trends in Korea are we going to bid goodbye in the coming years? What kind of heritage should be documented in the first place? Which new modes of communication and cooperation are going to develop and be shared in regions like East Asia and Central-Eastern Europe? In which directions shall Korean Studies scholars channel their effort to preserve knowledge of the past and embrace the future? How shall they nurture young generations of Korean Studies disciples within the worldwide education trends that encourage open classroom discussion, diversification, and creativity?

The conference is intended to be a forum for scholars to discuss and exchange research ideas in a broad range of fields including art, literature, linguistics, pedagogy, history, cultural and social studies.
